## **Deer Valley/ MetroPhoenix Water Festival, Nov. 6 2007**

### **Volunteer Jobs Descriptions**

**Area Coordinator** - in charge of a four-activity area, responsible for overall oversight, coordination, and problem solving in the area; assisted by Activity Monitors

**Activity Leaders/Presenters** - two Activity Leaders per activity will present an interactive activity to a maximum of 30 students each ½ hour; attendance at a training session is required.

**Activity Leader Assistants** - one to two Activity Leader Assistants per area will help the Activity Leaders present the activity.

**Activity Monitors** - greet the buses and provide each class with their schedule; guide a class through the schedule; assist the Area Coordinators as much as possible in keeping time and maintaining flow; may serve as parking lot attendants

**Staging Tent Crew** - responsible for distribution of water and ice to the stations, and student, teacher and parent packets to participants.

**Site Set-up Volunteers** -general set-up to get the site, materials and supplies ready for the big event

**Tear-Down and Clean-up Coordinator** – all area volunteers must help to clean up and pack equipment; the coordinator will direct the flow and pace of the clean-up.

**Pre-Festival Packagers** – pack stuffer items into teacher and student bags/packets; and/or prepare and pack festival supplies and equipment.
