Morgan began his playing career all over the valley with various soccer clubs. He graduated from high school locally at Marcos de Niza in Tempe, where he was an integral part of the

3-Time Soccer State Championship Dynasty (1990, 1991, 1992). After high school, Coach Lee continued his athletic and academic career at Scottsdale Community College. While at SCC, he earned the honors of team Captain and NCJAA All-American both his freshman and sophomore years.

Coach Lee graduated from Northern Arizona University in December of 1997 and started working for Phoenix College in January of 1998 as a Fitness Center Instructor and Strength and Conditioning Coach. During that year, Coach Lee also signed a contract to play soccer for the Arizona Sahuaros Professional Soccer Team.

Morgan continues to work as a Strength and Conditioning Coach, where he has helped the Phoenix College Women's Softball Team win Back-to-Back NJCAA D-II National Championships in 2000, 2001, 2004 and 2005. In addition, Coach Lee also serves the Phoenix College Athletic Department as an Assistant Athletic Director.

Along with his wife Keri and their two dogs, Coach Lee is happy to find his coaching home here at Phoenix College and is excited about the years to come.

Chris Sagar enters his 4th season as an Assistant/Goalkeeper Coach at Phoenix College. Sagar who holds an USSF National "C" license brings a wealth of knowledge and experience to this program. Sagar most recently serves as a fulltime Staff Trainer

and Goalkeeper Coach at Mesa Soccer Club. He was responsible for the technical and tactical development of competitive youth teams, as well as the implementation of a program of education and instruction for all of the club's goalkeepers.

Prior to this, he was the Head Coach of the Fort Collins Force, an amateur team competing in the W-League. This league being the second highest level of women's soccer behind the WUSA in the United States. There he led a team comprised of both current and former players from some of the nation's top collegiate soccer programs to 7-7-1 record. Of notable mention was his work with U-21 National Team/WUSA goalkeeper Emily Oleksiuk.

Sagar also served as an Assistant Women's Soccer Coach at Arizona State University in 2000. There he helped the young program to its most successful season to date (14-7-1) and to round two of the Division I NCAA Playoffs. Additionally, he led the varsity boy's Prescott High School team to Desert Sky titles in 1997-98 and 1998-99 and the State Semi-Finals each year amassing a 33-6 record. Sagar was named the Region's Coach of the Year for the 1998-99 season.

A native of Trinidad and Tobago, Sagar represented his country at the U-19 and U-23 (Olympic) levels playing in the Junior World Cup qualifying tournament in Guatemala 1988 and in CONCACAF qualifying rounds for the 1992 Olympic Games in Barcelona.

Sagar won a National Championship with Yavapai College in 1992 and earned the distinction of being named Most Valuable Goalkeeper at the National Tournament in both 1991 and 1992. In 1999 he received Honorable Mention on the NJCAA All Century Team. He finished his college career at the University of Wisconsin-Parkside.




Nicole Logan






