GENERAL INFORMATION

1. A processed Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) for 2010-2011 must be on file already or received before June 30, 2011. You only need to complete a FAFSA one-time per academic year. Your valid FAFSA record must be received by the last date of your enrollment for 2010-2011.
2. The student is responsible to know the rights and responsibilities in regard to receiving Federal financial aid. Additional information is available on the Phoenix College Financial Aid website and in the Phoenix College Catalog.
3. **Summer School 2011 Priority Deadline is April 8, 2011.** This means students who appear to be eligible for federal aid and have a complete financial aid file by the deadline may qualify to have their tuition due date extended and may be considered for a book store voucher. Students who complete their financial aid file after April 8, 2011 will be considered for financial aid but, must make their own arrangements to pay tuition costs by the due date, or sign up for the Tuition Payment Plan to avoid being dropped from classes.
4. Excess financial aid funds for students who meet all criteria will be released through the Maricopa Student Refund Program
BEGINNING: **June 6, 2011**
5. Students cannot receive federal aid from more than one school for the same period of enrollment. To attend more than one school during the same period of enrollment, the student may contact the Financial Aid Office to determine if they qualify for federal aid through a Consortium Agreement. A Consortium Agreement requires a minimum of six credits of enrollment if PC will be the Parent Institution. The deadline to submit a completed consortium agreement when Phoenix College is the parent institution: **May 26, 2011**
6. Summer financial aid awards are made pending the results of prior term grades and cumulative GPA. **Note:** Summer financial aid awards can be canceled for students who fail to maintain satisfactory academic progress in prior semesters. Refer to the "Standards of Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) for Financial Aid Eligibility" policy or on the Financial Aid Office web site.

7. Pell Grant awards will be based on level of enrollment for the summer session, as of the date indicated below. Courses added AFTER this date for the summer session will not be considered for an increase to Pell grant awards:

DIRECT LOAN INFORMATION

8. Students who borrowed the maximum annual loan amount during fall 2010 and/or spring 2011, and have NOT progressed in grade level (from a freshman to a sophomore), are not eligible for a summer school loan at PC.
9. All students must be enrolled in *at least six (6) credit hours at PC to borrow for the summer term.*
10. Loans are disbursed in at least two installments within the loan period.
11. All new loans require the completion of the entrance counseling and the Master Promissory Note before loan funds are released at PC.
12. All borrowers must be enrolled in the 10 week summer session to be considered for Direct Loan.

FEDERAL WORK-STUDY (FWS) INFORMATION

13. Federal FWS awards are contingent upon the availability of funds.
14. Priority consideration for FWS awards will be given to students who are currently employed under the FWS program at PC through spring 2011 and are already enrolled in PC fall 2011 classes.
15. During periods of enrollment students are limited to working no more than 20 hours per week. A portion of summer FWS earnings that exceed calculated need may be added to the expected family contribution for 2011-2012; this could reduce the amount of aid eligibility for the upcoming academic year.
16. Students who have graduated or are on a Maximum Timeframe will **NOT** be considered for FWS.
17. Student **MUST** be already enrolled at least 1/2x (6-8 credit hours) for fall 2011 at PC to be considered for FWS beyond May 13, 2011. It is recommended that students complete a 2011-2012 Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) before June 16, 2011.
