Oral Radiography Classes, Spring 2010 - *New Digital Format*

This course meets once a week for eight weeks and may be taken by those preparing to become certified to expose oral radiographs in the State of Arizona. To become x-ray certified, candidates must pass a written and clinical exam administered by the Dental Assisting National Board. Call DANB at: 1-800-367-3262 or visit their website at www.danb.org for exam information and application forms.

The lecture portion of the class may be taken separately as a review, or the entire program can be taken by those who need instruction in learning how to expose and process radiographs. Topics covered in the course will include radiation protection, film mounting, evaluation and interpretation of intraoral and extraoral radiographs, infection control, and the operation and maintenance of radiographic equipment.

Phoenix College is now utilizing digital radiography. ScanX phosphor plates will be used in place of traditional x-ray film in the lab. Interproximal and periapical techniques will be taught in the lab using dental x-ray replicas (DXTTRS). Participants will be allowed to provide a patient near the end of the eight week session. The textbook, *Radiographic Imaging for Dental Auxiliaries* is recommended and can be purchased through the Phoenix College Bookstore, (602) 285-7489.
