- 2. Proof of chicken pox (varicella) with titer or vaccine date
- 3. TB test must be within the last 6 months
- Other requirements:
  - 1. The college requires that drug screens be done before entering the clinical experience. Verification from your agency required.
  - 2. Each student must have a textbook (see information below).
  - 3. Scrubs or lab coat with slacks & collared shirts are required for clinical hours. Some facilities will furnish a lab coat onsite.
