Definition: Endowments are gifts to the NILD Leaders Foundation are created by the donor as a perpetual source of funding support for scholarships, program support or other designated purposes that fall within the Foundation's mission.
- Funding Requirements: A minimum contribution of \$10,000 is required before an endowment can be created, however donors have up to five years to reach that minimum level. If the endowment minimum is not reached as required, accumulated contributions will either be a) treated as a restricted fund and fully expended as soon practicable, or b) combined with a compatible, already existing endowment account.
- Investment and Spending Policies: Endowment funds are professionally managed as part of a carefully balanced investment portfolio that includes stocks, bonds and other approved instruments. Each year, endowment funds are awarded in amounts up to 5% of a three average of their year-end fund balances. Any unspent portion of the amount available for annual distribution shall be returned to principle balance of the endowment. Although unlikely, it is possible and permitted for annual endowment expenditures to invade the principle balance (defined as the total of the original amount of the endowment contribution and any subsequent contributions to the endowment principle) of the endowment.

**MAKING A GIFT
BY PAYROLL DEDUCTION**
